The Bolingbrook Park District Memorial Tree and Bench Program purchased and planted to commemorate people, organizations or special events. It also makes a unique gift for a special friend.

Memorial trees will be recorded on a display located in the Annerino Community Center lobby. A 3" x10" commemorative plaque is located at the base of each tree, and a personalized certificate suitable for framing will be issued.

Trees can be purchased anytime, however, planting will only take place in the spring or fall. The price is \$350 and the trees are guaranteed to live 20 years. In the event a Memorial tree dies, a new tree (*same variety and size as originally planted*) will be installed by the Park District.

Memorial benches are a wonderful way to pay tribute to a loved one while helping to beautify the park district. A parks representative will meet with you to discuss location of the bench. Price is \$750 and includes a 20-year warranty. A 3"x10" memorial plaque at the base of the bench is included. Order time is 6-8 weeks and two weeks for installation from time of receipt of the bench.



# Memorial Tree and Bench Program



## CONIFERS - EARLY FALL PLANTING

**White Pine:** Beautiful native pine with a soft pleasant appearance; a fast growing tree can attain a height over 75' tall.

**Colorado Spruce (blue or green):** Commonly known as blue spruce, available in blue or green needle variety; stately pyramidal tree 50' to 60'.

**Serbian Spruce:** Somewhat pyramidal with nice small soft bluish-green needles grows to 50' in height.

**Black Hills Spruce:** Desirable, dense symmetrical cone shape to this evergreen conifer. Slow grower 20' to 25' tall, 10' to 12' wide. Great landscape accent.

**Baldcypress:** A deciduous conifer native to Illinois; medium green color changing to a beautiful rust color in fall, will grow 50' to 60' tall in wet or dry conditions.

**Vanderwolf's Pine:** Distinctive, pyramid shaped pine with long, twisted silvery blue-green needles displayed on dense branches. A superior selection for lawn specimen and accent. Resistant to insects and disease. Moderate grower to 20'-30' tall, 10'-15' wide.

**White Fir:** This pyramidal shaped tree offers soft, blue-green foliage. Also known as concolor fir, it grows to 30'-50' tall with a 20'-30' spread.



## SHADE AND ORNAMENTAL TREES

**Sugar Maple:** Broadly oval in habit up to 50' tall; nice green summer color with outstanding fall colors of yellow, orange and scarlet. Spring/Fall planting.

**Autumn Blaze Maple:** Upright habit with a fast growth rate, has green summer color changing to scarlet red. Spring/Fall planting.

**Honeylocust:** Delicate foliage provides filtered shade; bright green leaves give way to a nice yellow fall color. Fall planting.

**Sweetgum:** Broad habit with a medium growth rate; attractive star shaped leaves turning a rich yellow to reddish-purple in fall. Spring planting.

**Kentucky Coffeetree:** Bold winter habit with highly distinctive bark; the tree can reach 75' in height and is adaptable to many soils. Fall planting.

**Tuliptree:** Large, fast growing, stately tree; tulip shaped, bright green leaves change to yellow in fall, tulip-like flowers on mature trees. Spring planting.

**Ginkgo:** Very slow growing with an upright, pyramidal shape; unusual fan-shaped leaves turn a nice buttery yellow in fall. Fall planting.

**Bur Oak:** A tree native to the Midwest. Large, round, open habit; very adaptable tree with interesting corky bark, fiddle-shaped leaves, and a medium growth rate. Spring planting.

**Red Oak:** Large, upright, rounded habit with a stately appearance; medium growth rate with a dark red fall color. Spring planting.

**Swamp White Oak:** A tall tree with a rounded, symmetrical habit; prefers moist soil and full sun. Attractive leaves that turn yellow to brown. Spring/Fall planting.

**Chinkapin Oak:** A very nice oak with unusual serrated leaves; upright and spreading with age, it has a medium-fast growth rate. Fall color ranges from yellow to orangish-brown. Spring planting.

**Winter King Hawthorn:** Wide-spreading 20' to 25' tall tree with white spring flowers and nice silvery bark; fall color is yellow with tiny red fruit. Spring planting.

**Ironwood:** A 20' to 30' tall tree for sun or shade; the leaves turn yellow in fall and often persist into winter. Spring/Fall planting.

**Amelanchier (Serviceberry):** Reaching a height of 20', this tree has an upright habit with beautiful white blossoms in spring and outstanding red-orange fall color. Fall planting.

**Ornamental Crabapple:** Five varieties are offered.

- **Donald Wyman:** 20' x 20'; green foliage with red to pink buds open to white flowers.
- **Snowdrift:** 20' x 20'; green foliage with pink buds and snow white flowers and orange persistent fruit.
- **Adams:** 25' x 20'; green with red tinged foliage and single, clear pink flowers and yellow/orange fall color.
- **Prairiefire:** 20' x 20'; dark, reddish-green foliage with red buds and rose flowers and red persistent fruit.
- **Sugartyme:** 18' x 15'; medium green foliage with white flowers and dark red persistent fruit.
- **Tina:** 4' - 5'; plenty of pink buds open to 1" white flowers and purple-red persistent fruit. Glossy foliage in summer.

**Crabapples — Fall planting.**

**Pekin Lilac:** Graceful, upright growth habit reaching 15' to 20'; fragrant white flower in June and exfoliating bark adds interest. Spring/Fall planting.

**Red Bud:** Multi-stemmed or low branched small tree growing 20' to 25' tall; has rosy purple flower buds in spring before the heart-shaped foliage appears. Spring planting.

**Ohio Buckeye:** This 20'-40' tall tree creates dense shade and has attractive red fall color early in the season.

**Accolade Elm:** a 40'-6-' tall vase shaped tree displaying yellow fall color. Good resistance to Dutch elm disease.
