The program length and fee for youth group programs varies by age of participants unless noted. The minimum group size is six, maximum is 20. If a group is smaller than six, the group will be asked to pay for the minimum.

1 hour programs	\$6/\$4 resident id discount per participant
1 ½ hour programs	\$8/\$6 resident id discount per participant
2 hour programs	\$9/\$7 resident id discount per participant
